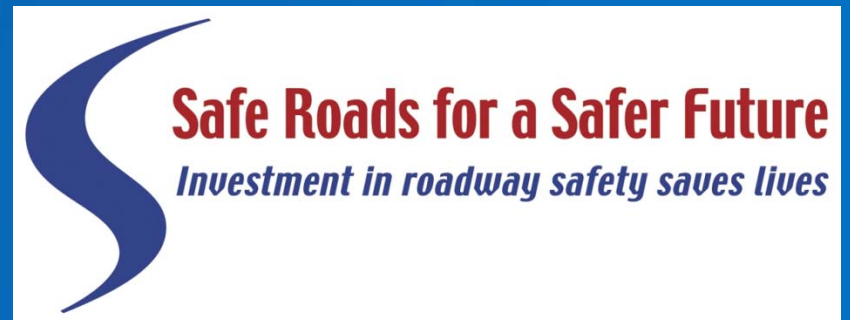

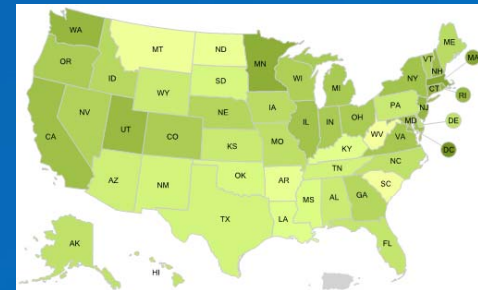

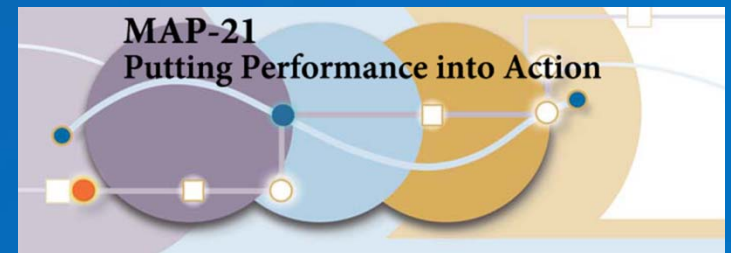

Transportation Performance Management

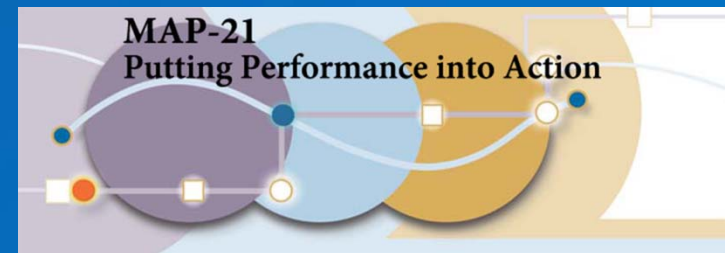
- FHWA defines Transportation Performance Management as a strategic approach that uses system information to make investment and policy decisions to achieve national performance goals.
- Safety - To achieve a significant reduction in traffic fatalities and serious injuries on all public roads.





Transportation Performance Management

- Safety Performance Measures
 - Number of Fatalities
 - Rate of Fatalities per 100 million vehicle miles travelled
 - Number of Serious Injuries
 - Rate of Serious Injuries per 100 million VMT
