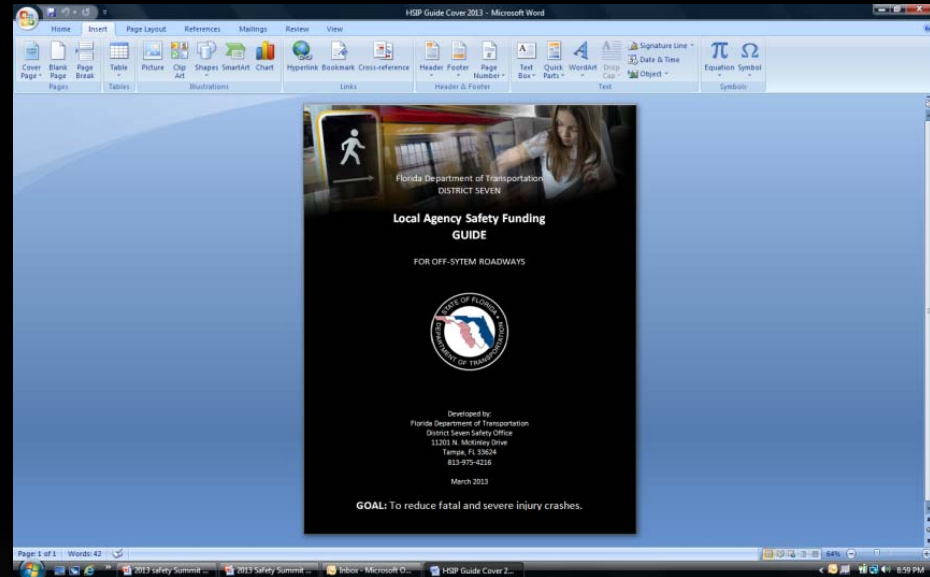

# *New CTST HSIP Application Requirement for 2014*

- Prior to the June 2014 application deadline
- Each safety project shall be presented at a CTST Meeting
- To provide local agencies opportunity to discuss project concepts
- Solicit feedback prior to the application due date
- Attend at least 4 CTST meetings per year\*

# *Administering the HSIP Funds*

- FDOT receives around \$118 M each fiscal year.
- Each of the 7 FDOT Districts are allocated a portion of total.
- Administration of safety funds varies across districts.
- Some districts do safety projects in-house.
- In-house and local agency safety projects via Local Agency Program (LAP)
- Equipment purchase, design-build push button.



# *Administering the HSIP Funds*

- District 7 delivers funds directly to locals.
- D7 has in place a Safety Team comprised of FDOT personnel, FHWA personnel, and safety consultants to assist and facilitate process.
- Open dialogue with local agency staff throughout the process.
- Safety team members serve as D7 Safety Ambassadors to assigned counties.
