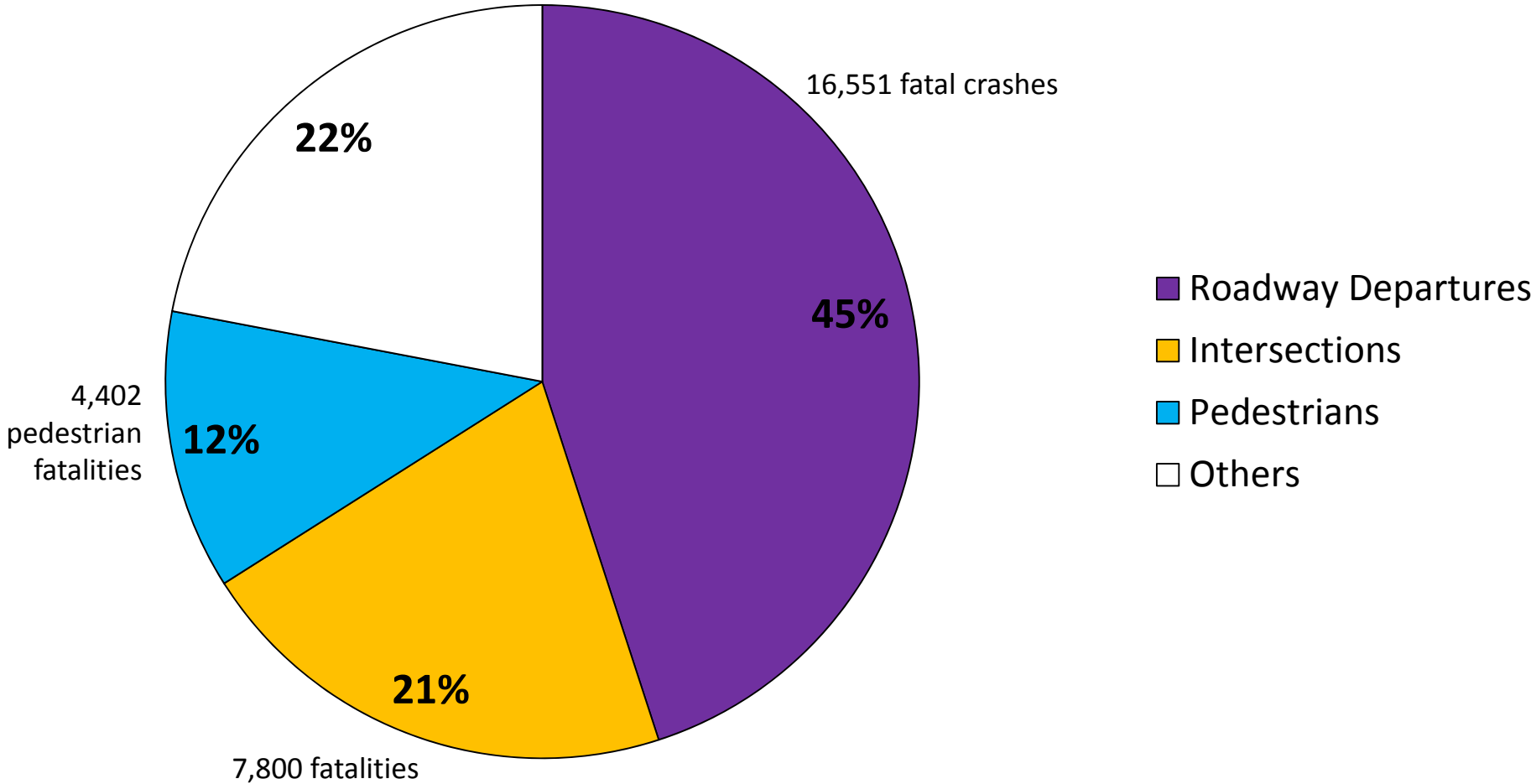

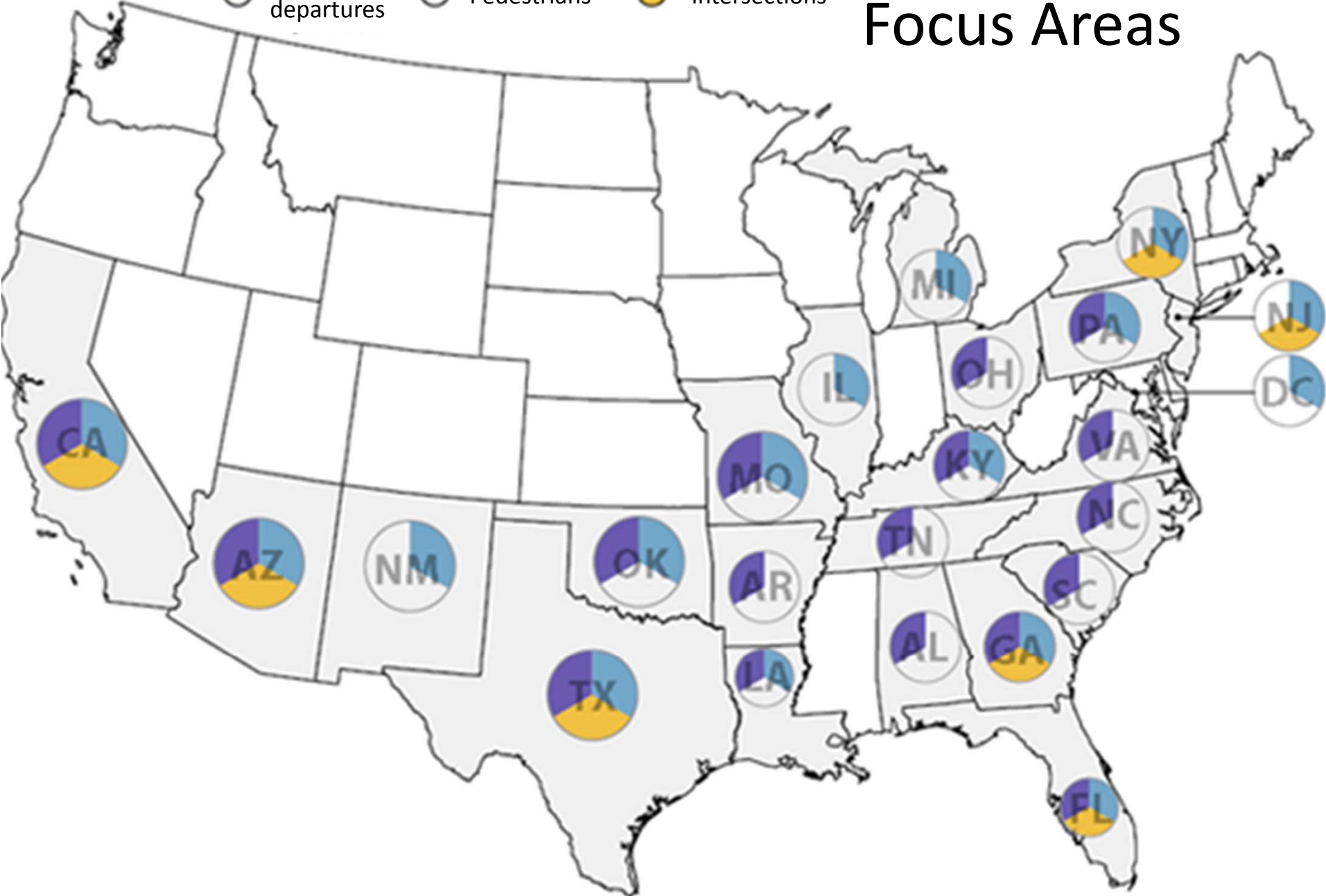

Corridor access management	Enhanced delineation and friction for horizontal curves	Pedestrian hybrid beacon
Backplates with retroreflective borders	Safety Edge	Road diet
