

The purpose of the Safety Summit is to:


- Provide the Department and local agency management-level staff with key information on the traffic safety issues specific to the Tampa Bay region.
- Brief local agency partners on current efforts and strategies to reduce crashes throughout the region, primarily focusing on the State's commitment to dedicate state and federal safety funds to local agency projects as part of the Highway Safety Improvement Program:
 - Over \$500,000 annually in local roadway project design support (including LAP project design)
 - Over \$1,000,000 annually in local roadway safety engineering & education support (including CTST education, Safety Ambassadors, and LAP support).
 - Over \$2,000,000 annually in local roadway safety project funding to address intersection safety, pedestrian safety and rural lane departures.
- Reach a consensus relative to enhancing the transportation safety partnership between FDOT and local agencies moving forward.
