



## Minutes of the February 24, 2016 Pasco CTST Meeting

Minutes from January were reviewed and approved with changes. Introductions were made.

Lucy from CUTR gave a presentation on WALKWISE.

### OLD BUSINESS

Bala gave a summary about the Safety Summit. Matt wants to do a 2 step process, like a pre-screening to see if projects are feasible for safety funding.

Mike Bunk discussed a project along Morris Bridge Road, it consists of about 600 ft. of guardrail. There is a need for additional safety materials.

Georgann will be in John Long Middle School on March 8<sup>th</sup>. They now have 9 High Schools participating in the Battle of the Belts challenge.

There will be a new elementary school opening next fall across the street / around the corner from John Long Middle School.

Discussion continues about Baily Drive and Rowan Road and additional access management. Have not seen any additional requests for permits.

Discussion was had about the RSA for Seven Springs Road. Mike B. and Mike Z. will follow up with Dave S and Dave C. respectively. Discussion continued about road diets, and conversation was had about Veteran's Village. No left turn into neighborhood- high volume. This could possibly shift traffic back onto 19. Possible traffic timing issue. Discussion was had about effective modeling in order to assist with current traffic conditions.

National Click It or Ticket wave happens in June.

There is a new LEL Coordinator, Tim Roberts. Florida is hosting the NHTSA Region 4 at Miramar Beach, they will be looking at fatalities. FL is up 485 fatalities in 2015. Pasco and Pinellas were down. FLAKA- new synthetic drug. Sherriff's seem to be less inclined to enforce certain laws as they could impact votes.

Allen Howell talked about the BPAC meeting. Passionate cyclists. Allen also gave a presentation about projects in the next few years. Discussion was had about NE Pasco County riders.

### NEW BUSINESS

Ashley reported that they are on track to do 39 or 40 schools for the school year and working on some summer school programs. Allen asked to coordinate data collection from the schools. Walking surveys.

It was noted that other than Thomas Banks, there were no other LEOs in attendance, again.



In engineering news, several road projects will be completed soon;

- Interlocking Road- Odessa Elementary
- Chancy Road- Double Branch Elementary
- 8 feet Trail being constructed along Progress Pathway, currently 4 feet. Along CR 54- the length of Progress Parkway.

No crash data was currently available.

Speed limit revisions will be upcoming.

Final acceptance of SR 54 through Zephyrhills, SR 52 to Erin and Belamy.

County Line Road- Hernando Co and Mariner were discussed.

Mr. Howell offered the MPO staff conference room for an alternative meeting location. Mike Bunk also offered a location at their county offices.

An item about a meeting to be held at the MPO office location in April will be on the March agenda.
