



### Minutes for the January 2016 Pasco CTST Meeting

Welcome and introductions were made. Minutes were reviewed and approved with several changes- use of last names for clarity, removal of a sentence “The speed needs to be lowered” to read traffic is heavy, speeds will need to be evaluated along Seven Springs. Someone = Dave S and Mike B. Need date, time and attendance to be included in the minutes and posted on the website.

Bala spoke about the safety Summit and gave an overview of the HSIP. Two changes were that there will be assistance earlier in the process to save time and that Safety projects will be looked at all year. Discussions were had about equipment- reflectors, bright sticks, and signal back reflectors. A reminder was made that safety cannot replace regular maintenance.

Mike Bunk asked about a shared crash data information, discussion was had about an issue regarding Mark Wilson.

Suggestion was made that feet per second become a campaign. Including discussion about intersection and points of conflict in need of more relative analysis.

Discussion was had about motorcycle safety and training in connection to stopping distances.

Discussion was had about PIEV (PIVE?)

Discussion was had about motorcycle safety, Rail Roads and vision requirements.

Discussion was had about car seats and helmets.

Pasco County has two vacant positions. When those positions are filled it will speed up these processes.

There is a correction to be made about sidewalk responsibility.

Discussion was had, including sidewalk safety and ADA issues, leading into hazardous walking conditions.

There was no report on enforcement as there were no LEOs present.

BPAC reported having a regional meeting with Hillsborough and Pinellas Counties, the Vision Zero plan was discussed.
