Welcome and introductions were made. Steve Daniels asked about getting a traffic signal at County Line Road and Waterfall. Discussion was had. A request for a traffic study to see if it could meet warrants. Discussion continued about the extension of County Line Road and Ayers Rd. Discussion was had.

Sunshine Road and Jaqueline--- Rd. Discussion included mention of a sight issue, a railing appears to be in question. Possibly have traffic assistance since the 50 improvements are complete as this was a bypass. Mariner intersection will have slight improvements. Discussion continued.

Mondon Hill Road was discussed.

Discussion was had on Good Neighbor Trail. A study is being conducted. Results will follow.

Discussion was had about a Rail Road crossing 50 By Pass, Main and Emmerson. CSX does not fund improvements, discovery if it is a State Road. Appeared to be an issue. There will be continued aspects. Discussion about Railroad crossings and levels. FDOT is not allowed to conduct anything within 30 feet of the crossings without CSX.

Bike Ped Subcommittee was discussed. The Committee will be put to rest, until it is again needed.

Beverly Howard continued to request support for her Trail. Suntrail network has some funding. The Coast to Coast is the first piece to get funded. Ongoing meetings about maintenance of trails. Discussion was had on trail maintenance.

Dedicated funding continues to be an issue for maintenance. Discussion was had.

Call was made for problem locations.

School District asked for information or a study about Cloverleaf to Brooksville Elementary School. There is apparently becoming a large issue of children coming out of a 55 and older restricted community. There has been reports of children crossing the road in front of the School District. Discussion was had.

Danielle Barth discussed Safe Routes to School activities. Helmets and safety presentations. She has presented to about 2000 students.

West Central Driver Improvement announced that the next Victim Impact Panel is January 12th.

Tom Banks discussed the Law Enforcement aspects of the Holiday DUI, and the Click It or Ticket Campaign. He provided information about reporting changes. Numbers seem to be up this year. Asking for more assistance on social media push.
