



# Dang tourists! Or is it the retirees?

## Actually ....

- Though tourism is part of Hillsborough economy, traffic patterns are more commuter-focused

- Average age similar to the national average
- Percent native-born also similar

## What does the data tell us about our county?


#### For every 1 fatal crash, 8 incapacitating injury crashes. Altogether ~1500 /year.

- 75% of fatal crashes occur on roads with posted speeds 40 mph +, whether they involve pedestrians, cyclists, or are strictly vehicular.
- 75% of fatal & incapacitating injury crashes occur on only one-third of our roads.
- 33% of fatal crashes involve aggressive driving. (It's 42% of fatal vehicular crashes.)
- 24% of fatal crashes involve lack of lighting. (It's 39% of fatal pedestrian crashes.)
- 23% of fatal crashes involve intoxication. (U.S. rate is 29%.)
- Pedestrian crashes that include injuries are more severe: one-third result in death or incapacitation. We average more than one pedestrian injury crash every day.
- In the US, motor vehicle crashes are the leading cause of death for young people <35 yrs.

## East Tampa, 45mph posted: Busch Boulevard 6-lane divided -- 15 fatalities & 110 serious injuries, 5 yrs






Why would anyone do this?



#### Busch Blvd & 40<sup>th</sup> St


- Adjacent transit-oriented neighborhoods, stores all along road
- Probably will have to walk well out of my way to use crosswalk; distance to next signal-protected crosswalk is .6 mi
- Survey: "Drivers don't yield to walkers in crosswalk"
- Nine lanes to cross on Busch at this intersection
- No safe place to wait in the median






What if getting to the grocery store means crossing Busch Blvd? With bags? And kids?












## Lack of lighting: one-quarter of fatal crashes



# Discussion Question: Safety & Mode Share

What do you think about the relationship between a community's VMT (vehicle miles travelled every day) and the community's crash rate? Is it:

- a) Assuming higher VMT increases exposure, then reducing singleoccupant vehicle mode share has the potential to reduce crashes.
- b) That may be true, but if the population continues to grow (as in much of Florida), VMT and therefore crash growth will likely outpace any advances based on reducing single-occupant-vehicle (SOV) mode share.
- c) Reducing SOV mode share not only reduces exposure to vehicle crashes, it also raises the visibility of alternate modes and increases driver awareness, so the safety benefit may be higher than the change in VMT alone would suggest.
